Examination : shoulder MRI;

Sagittal oblique FSE T2W
Coronal oblique SE T1W
Coronal oblique fat sat FSE T2W and PD
Axial fat sat FSE T2w

Acromion configuration is type II. Acromioclavicular joint is normal.
Subacromial space is clear.

Increased signal intensity is present in the supraspinatus tendon consistent with tendinosis.

The other rotator cuff tendons are unremarkable.

There is minima effusion in subacromial subdeltoid bursae and subcoracoid recess.

Glenohumeral joint and glenoid labrums are normal.

There is cyst in the humeral head measuring 9x7x10mm. There is also subchondral degenerative cystic resorbtion on the anterior surface of humerus head and bone bruise on the medial surface of the humeral neck.

Glenoid fossa and periarticular muscles are normal.
